Frequently Asked Questions

Is the funding only available for species listed as threatened on the IUCN Red List?

We are happy to consider proposals for species of any threat level and any subspecies.

Are rescue and rehabilitation activities eligible?

Yes, rescue and rehabilitation activities are eligible.

Are education and awareness activities eligible?

Yes, if they are part of a wider conservation strategy for your project.

Are there any geographical restrictions on where a project can take place?

No, however we are keen to fund in-situ research and conservation work, therefore desk studies are ineligible for this funding.

Should the grant cover the whole project, or can it be part of a larger project?

The grant can be for the whole project or as part of a wider project, however any projects where the Parrot Conservation Grant is funding less than 40% of the project total is unlikely to be funded.

Should we list any additional funding already obtained or applied for?

You can include a sentence on this in your pre-proposal, however the detail of this will be explored for those who move on to the full proposal stage of the application.

What is the expected time frame for the project and when should projects start?

Projects should start within one month of the funding being received and should be for a duration of no longer than 12 months.

What will be the full proposal process?

The full proposal process will be an extension of the pre-proposal submitted and will include a detailed budget request, timeline and objectives.

When will you be informed if you have reached the full proposal stage?

The full proposal template will be sent to successful pre-proposal applicants by the middle of June 2022.
